Agenda Item #10	<ul> <li>State College Duals</li> <li>Same tournament as attended last year, costs would likely be a bit higher but it was a wonderful experience for the wrestlers, parents were very helpful and supportive</li> <li>Entry fee would be around \$600, the house for two nights would be about \$1,600, plus a meal for the group would be needed</li> <li>Motion to participate again with a \$2,500 budget - Jason <ul> <li>2nd - Todd</li> <li>Passed</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		
Agenda Item #11	<ul> <li>Team SNAP</li> <li>Currently paying \$19.50/month for JotForm, but this system is limited and can only be operated by one person (has been Jason).</li> <li>Clear needs: more people to be involved and have a hand in operations, more functional for our needs and being able to customize registrations and reports.</li> <li>Team SNAP would fulfill these needs + allow for refunds (w/in 90 days) &amp; could support website creation/management down the road. Wrestlers can be grouped allowing for communications with small group(s) or whole group by leadership or coaches.</li> <li>Negatives to acknowledge are the overall expense (\$959/year for up to 150 wrestlers, 151+ would incur additional \$500 fee) and the cost of processing fees (more than paypal/venmo). Despite this, this is the best option available to help meet our needs.</li> <li>Motion to use Team SNAP for management software/app needs - Jason <ul> <li>2nd - Keith</li> <li>Passed</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		
Agenda Item #12	<ul> <li>Registration Cost <ul> <li>Last year registration was \$100/wrestler</li> <li>To keep up with growing costs, we'll need to bump registration up to \$125.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Volunteer fee - paid at registration, but reimbursed after fulfilling an outlined expectation of helping in some way; tabling this until at least next season or later</li> <li>Sibling discount - would be helpful for many families, we can make 2nd child (and any additional children) \$100 instead of \$125</li> <li>Coaches reimbursement <ul> <li>Head coach of group to get 100% reimbursement of registration costs at the end of the season after fulfilling the role</li> <li>Helping coaches to get 50% reimbursement of registration costs at the end of the season after verification by the head coach of a sufficient level of commitment in fulfilling the role</li> </ul> </li> <li>Motion to adopt increased registration, sibling discount, &amp; coaches reimbursement - Erin 2nd - Lauren <ul> <li>Passed</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
